As regards the gully in High Hatton which it has been discovered that there is a discharge from a biodisc from the new development, is now causing concern to the residents in the village.

The Parish Clerk was asked to contact Shropshire Council's planning department to check if a planning condition was agreed on these conversions for the septic tanks to feed through a digester system and then into the roadside gully. An enquiry would also be made through Shropshire Council's Public Protection Team.

An area considered was the area around the Millennium Oak. Agreed to ask Ian Wellings only to cut two mower widths from the highway so that we could consider planting in the remaining area.
