Action**024.17.C RAF Shawbury**

Sqn Ldr Mark Jones introduced Flt Lt Charlie Gawne who would now be representing RAF Shawbury at future meetings.

Mark then went through the programme of events planned for this year. He added that Group Captain Chuck Norris would be taking over control of the station in May.

025.17.C Highway Matters

Cllr's expressed concern over a number of outstanding issues that had still not been resolved. These included; Yew Tree Villa flooding is still the same, at times completely across the road. Shropshire Council (SC) stated back in November 2016 that this area was assessed by their drainage team. What action do they intend to take. ??

SC also stated back in November that their technician will inspect the worn out double white lines on the A53 from the Blakeley/High Hatton cross roads to the junction for Ellerdine. We hope that SC will not face a vicarious liability claim for any fatal accident along this stretch of road due to these lines not being visible.

Cllr Greg Shaw reported that the gully in High Hatton by the notice board just by the junction to the new development has still not been attended to and now residents are expressing concern over foul sewerage smell from this.

Also the finger post at the 'T' junction in Stanton as you approach the village from Moreton Corbet, which Shropshire Council recently repaired, has now been damaged again and overhanging the highway.
