Most of it is obvious and well observed by the clear majority of us, such as keeping to marked footpaths, closing farm gates, keeping dogs on a lead near farm animals etc. Unfortunately, one of the responsibilities outlined in the Countryside Code does seem to be slipping some people's memories around Stanton and Hine Heath, namely Dog Poop!

INSIDE THIS ISSUE:	Everyone knows how unpleasant dog mess is and it can cause infections, so always clean up after your dog and get rid of the mess responsibly – 'bag it and bin it'. Make sure your dog is wormed regularly to protect it, other animals and people.
