## NEWS FROM ST ANDREW'S CHURCH



### MEETING OUR NEEDS

For some of us, the last 18 months or so have taken a Herculean effort. To keep going in the midst of the pandemic and all its restrictions has taken all of our energy and willpower. In my role as vicar, I've come across many people who are exhausted, frustrated and (in some cases) just about ready to give up. It reminds me of the Prophet Elijah, who appears in the Old Testament (particularly in the Book of 1 Kings).



At one point, Elijah is on the run from King Ahab and Queen Jezebel – two nasty characters who want him dead for teaching about God and doing mighty works in God's name. He ends up in the wilderness, where he is so exhausted and terrified that he asks God to end his life. Instead, God twice sends an angel with food and water, encouraging Elijah to eat, drink and sleep. Afterwards, God appears to Elijah and strengthens him to carry on, before appointing another man (Elisha) as an assistant. This isn't just a cosmic pep talk. God provides for Elijah's physical, mental and spiritual needs. He demonstrates a deep understanding of what each human being requires to survive and thrive.

If you're feeling exhausted and lacking in willpower, I'd love to invite you to church, where you will have the opportunity to meet with the living God who understands all our needs.

May God's blessing rest upon you.

Did You Know....that 100 years ago in September 1921 —The "Poplar Rates Rebellion" broke out in London after several members of Poplar Borough Council were arrested for refusing to hand over payments to London County Council. For the first time in more than six years, residents of the UK were allowed to have alcoholic beverages served to them at pubs, restaurants and hotels in the evening, as restrictions issued in 1915 under the Defence of the Realm Act 1914 were lifted. The British government cabinet met outside of England for the first time, holding an emergency session at the Town House of the city of Inverness in Scotland.

Whilst I am still old school & prefer a grid reference, What3Words has gained momentum & is now commonly used by

emergency services, etc. So can I suggest we all download & try the App?

#### What is what3words?

What3words is a smartphone app that divides the entire planet into 57 trillion squares, each measuring three metres by three metres, and assigns each a unique sequence of three words. The sequence pinpoints the location of the user exactly, and can be given to the emergency services if you get lost or stranded. For example, the entrance to Ludlow Castle has been given the sequence education.briskly.presented, Shrewsbury's The Quarry is penned at blast.brains.fires, while the top of The Long Mynd is commenced.limbs.mend

The app is particularly useful when calling the emergency services as it can often be difficult in explaining to operators where exactly they are needed. Knowing the what 3 words for your location will enable the call takers to quickly ascertain where you are. This is particularly beneficial for our rural, isolated communities.

### Stolen Quad Bike

In the early hours of Thursday the 19th August 2021 a quad bike, valued at over £9000, was stolen from a farm in the Bayston Hill area. Luckily the owner had installed a tracking device and after receiving real time information from the tracking company the quad was found nearby and returned to the farm, all within 30 minutes.

Please consider protecting your valuable agricultural machinery with trackers, they really do work!

#### **Criminals Using Drones's**

The police are investigating suspicious activity near to Broseley. A red Ford Transit van was seen on Bould Lane and an unidentified male, with an East European accent, was operating a drone in the area. When challenged, the man packed away the drone and left the area in the van. A vehicle registration was taken, however, the details taken do match a red Ford Transit. It is possible that it was being driven with false plates. Officers were on patrol nearby in Shirlett and deployed to the Smithies to conduct a search for the vehicle, unfortunately there was no sign of it.

The North Wales police force have reported several incidents in the past where "Drones" have been used prior to selective thefts of valuable items
