### **Phone Scammer**

We were called last night by a scammer at half past midnight claiming to be from the National Fraud Agency & saying that they had someone in custody in Shrewsbury who, on arrest, was in possession of our bank details. The scammers had our names and initials and claimed to also have our mobile numbers & to be were aware that there was a substantial sum of money in the account. I'm sure you can all see where this was leading.

Having reported this to the Police, they explained that this is a new tactic - calling when you will be asleep & therefore dis-orientated and hoping to catch you off-guard.

The Police are taking this seriously and we are reporting to our banks as well. Please spread the word & be aware of this new tactic. Please do report to the Police locally, action fraud & your bank if you are targeted.

#### STOP, HANG UP, Dial 159

If you get ANY unsolicited call from your bank, the Police or any figure of authority - STOP, HANG UP, Dial 159

159 is a new (Pilot) service that will connect you to your bank fraud department. The call you have just received will be a Scam call and you can report it. Pease spread the word!

### **HMRC** warns students of scams

HMRC is warning university students to be wary of potential scams, especially if they have a part-time job and are new to interacting with the department.

Nearly half of all tax scams offer fake tax refunds, which HMRC does not offer by SMS or email. The criminals involved are usually trying to steal money or personal information to sell on to others. HMRC is a familiar brand, which scammers abuse to add credibility to their scams.
