

People looking to snap up online holiday deals ahead of the summer are being warned to stay extra alert and do their research before booking their getaways, as new data reveals victims lost a total of over £11 million to holiday fraud last year.

To protect yourself from holiday fraud search to check the travel company is legitimate, , especially if you haven't used them before. Use consumer websites, or reviews from people (or organisations) that you trust.

Neighbourhood Watch Chas Warren

This week we are highlighting 2 fraud threats that are appearing both locally and nationally.

Digital Phone Line Upgrade

Criminals are posing as BT staff and phoning residents to ask them for their personal and payment details in order to upgrade their phone lines to the digital service. If you refuse to cooperate then they threaten to cut off your landline. They are also using emails with similar messages.

As with other frauds, the criminal will also add pressure by claiming the deadline is imminent, even though the deadline set up by BT is January 2027.

How to Stay Safe

- Ignore any requests for payments and financial information
- Your provider will never ask for money to upgrade to the digital service

Some providers are also employing door to door sales techniques to get residents to upgrade to their service. Please feel free to share these messages with any vulnerable friends, relatives or neighbours

Always check their identity and if you are not sure, phone that company to check the representative is genuine. Also, never be pressured to make an instant decision on the doorstep

GWR "UK Annual Pass"

This potential fraud has been circulating for a while now, mainly on Facebook. The tempting offer is a "£3 Great Western Railway UK Annual Pass" which could give you unlimited travel around the country.

As with so many frauds, this does sound "too good to be true", and whilst the website you are directed too may look like an official GWR website, it has been confirmed that no such offer is available and should be ignored.
