NEWS FROM ST ANDREW'S CHURCH



Archbishop Justin Welby



The Most Revd Justin Welby was ordained in 1992 after an 11-year career in the oil industry. He spent his first 15 years serving in Coventry diocese, often in places of significant deprivation.

In 2002 he was made a Canon of Coventry Cathedral, where he jointly led its international reconciliation work. During this time he worked extensively in Africa and the Middle East. Archbishop Justin has had a passion for reconciliation and peace-making ever since.

He was Dean of Liverpool from 2007 to 2011 and Bishop of Durham from 2011 to 2012, before being announced as the 105th Archbishop of Canterbury in late 2012.

On 21st March 2013, he was installed as Archbishop of Canterbury in a service at Canterbury Cathedral. In his sermon he said: "There is every possible reason for optimism about the future of Christian faith in our world and in this country." The present environmental and economic challenges, and those of human development and global poverty, "can only be faced with extraordinary Christ-liberated courage."

Setting out a vision for the Church, he said: "The Church transforms society when it takes the risks of renewal in prayer, of reconciliation and of confident declaration of the good news of Jesus Christ." Click here to see more about The Most Revd Justin Welby.

Hare Coursing

As we see the crops coming off the fields, the criminals who like to practice hare coursing are planning their illegal activities. Look out for 'long dogs' such as Lurchers.



These are usually people involved in serious crime coming for a day out in the countryside. It is not unusual for them to be armed. Certainly not the sort of people we want hanging around our area.

So if you see any unusual activity (anything that makes you look twice). please discretely note the details, maybe take photographs & report it as a matter of urgency. If a crime is being committed use 999.

Anti Social Behaviour Week -North Wales Police

In our rural communities, the Future Farms Cymru project is being masterminded by North Wales Police's pioneering Rural Crime Team and, as part of the scheme, sensors linked to an app alert farmers immediately if anything is stolen.

Commenting, North Wales Police and Crime Commissioner Andy Dunbobbin commented: "Anti-social behaviour is a scourge on our communities and one that I am determined to address as part of my Police and Crime Plan, in close co-operation with North Wales Police.

"People have the right to feel safe and secure and no-one should feel afraid or intimidated when going about their everyday life and business.

"The ASB Awareness Week campaign is a really valuable way of highlighting the support on offer to residents and visitors experiencing anti-social behaviour. I would urge anyone to report any incidents of anti-social behaviour they experience, whether to their local Council officers, or to the local policing team.
