Beware When Usings ATM's

Recent incidents involving 2 males targeting elderly people using the Morrisons ATM's. They have been seen on CCTV observing when pin numbers are entered, then distracting victims whilst ejecting the bank card and pocketing it. They have given the victim a made up story about the card being swallowed, saying that the same has happened to them. Please take steps to cover the keypad when entering your pin number and be wary of people who are in close proximity.

Keep Your software updated?

Software updates are an important part of staying secure online. You'll often hear about the new features or performance improvements in a software update, but what isn't talked about as often are the bug fixes and security improvements. Out-of-date software and apps contain weaknesses. This makes them easier to hack. Companies fix the weaknesses by releasing updates. When you update your devices and software, this helps to keep hackers out. Why would cyber criminals target me? Your device contains a lot of personal data that is highly valuable if it fell into the hands of a fraudster. The likelihood is your device will contain your full name, date of birth, address, bank details,

Wildlife Crime - A Step In The Right Direction

Ross Pittam, aged 28, was found on the Davenport Estate in Worfield, Bridgnorth, with a weapon after the gamekeeper heard gunshots coming from the woods. Police found another man also carrying a loaded air rifle.

Further inspections of the area were carried out and officers located the defendant's car, which contained another air rifle, the firearms were seized. Pittam claimed he was given permission to hunt pigeons on the private land, but was unable to provide details of who had given him the permission.

Pittam, of Walsall, was found guilty of trespassing on land with an air weapon, and possessing an air weapon in a public place on October 15. He has now been sentenced at Telford Magistrates Court to 200 hours of unpaid work and ordered to pay £715 in court costs. He also had to surrender his guns.

PC Phillip Nock of West Mercia Police said: "We welcome the outcome of this case and are pleased with the sentencing that was handed down. Generally speaking, convictions relating to wildlife crimes in the UK remains relatively low, so this is a really positive outcome and we hope this will lead as an example to anyone who doesn't think there are conse-
