NEIGHBOURHOOD MATTERS.

VILLAGE DEFIBRILLATOR

The Village's public access defibrillator or Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is installed in a purpose built cabinet at the Stanton Arms for use in a medical emergency. If someone collapses and you call 999 then the operator will give you instructions over the phone on how to access the cabinet; if you have never used an AED they will talk you through its use if needed.

We also have a small group of volunteers who have been trained by West Midland Ambulance Service in Basic Life Support (BLS) and use of the AED who will eventually form a group of first responders on call through an automated cascade telephone system. We have not held refresher training for some time now so I have contact West

Midlands Ambulance Service to come and provide training in the village halls again.
