

EXTRA CARE ON RURAL ROAD DURING HARVEST SEASON

The Safer Roads Partnership, Warwickshire and West Mercia Police are warning motorists of the dangers that may be present at this time of year as farmers are using the roads more when harvesting and moving produce. With this burst of activity traditionally sees a rise in road collisions, many of which are preventable. Collisions occur involving agricultural vehicles on roads with 60 mph speed limits and many near turnings into farms. While farmers have a duty of care to clear roads of excessive mud and to use the roads in a responsible way during busy traffic periods by pulling into lay-bys or a place to allow other vehicles to pass safely. Us general motorists need reminding to take extra care and have consideration and patience during the harvest season.
